## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COTATI-ROHNERT PARK UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS,	Cotati-Rohnert Park Unified School District, County of Sonoma, California is dedicated to providing a top-quality education to all students in Cotati and Rohnert Park schools; and
WHEREAS,	the Board of Trustees of the District has determined both supporting academic programs and expanding, upgrading, repairing, improving and better equipping educational facilities within the District are required to enable the District to maintain student achievement growth, attract and retain teachers, and protect the quality of education for all students in the District; and
WHEREAS,	the District believes each and every student who attends our local schools deserves a quality education in a safe and modern learning environment; and
WHEREAS,	the Board ordered an election to take place on June 3, 2014 to determine whether general obligation bonds of the District shall be issued and sold in the maximum principal amount of \$80,000,000 for the purpose of raising money to finance school facilities and property of the District;
WHEREAS,	this ordered election is now known as Measure $\underline{}$ ; and
BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Cotati-Rohnert Park Unified School District assures the following: Upon passage of MeasureB_ proceeds from the sale of the bonds shall be used to upgrade facilities, improve classrooms and improve instructional technology at all schools in the District consistent with the terms of Resolution 1314-12.
