Note:

CMAS: California Multiple Award Schedules are one type of Leveraged Procurement Agreement made available by the California Department of General Services and allowed under the California Public Contract Code. They are based on Federal General Services Administration contracts and are a cost-effective alternative to bidding.

CUPCCAA: The district adopted the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act in June 2016. The Act provides that public projects of \$45,000 or less may be performed by negotiated contract or by purchase order, that public projects of \$175,000 or less may be let to contract by the informal procedures set forth in the Act, and that public projects of more than \$175,000 shall be let to contract by formal bidding procedures.
