Prior to the 2011-12 school year the Board declared 20+/acres on Keiser Avenue surplus and listed it for sale. The
Board subsequently had a listing agreement and then a
contract for sale. The contract included contingencies that
eventually were not met so the District retained
ownership. The Board has no listing agreement with any
broker to sell the property at this time. The
Superintendent is seeking direction from the Board on the
following options:

- Remove the property from surplus and take it off of the market
- Keep the property as surplus and entertain offers
- Keep the property as surplus and retain the service of ε broker

3. Labath Property

The District is working around our current tenant to modernize the facility on Labath Avenue. We have agreed to house Sonoma County Office of Education transition age (adult) special education students on the campus, relocating them from University Elementary. We are also working with the Sonoma County Special Education Local Plan Area to house the Adaptive Technology Center. We intend to use other space at the site for records storage and for instructional and/or professional development purposes.

There is additional undeveloped property that has drawn interest from a community based non-profit, the Community Support Network, to potentially develop housing for transition age youth who are at risk of being or are homeless.

The Board indicated their willingness to consider a proposal from Community Support Network for a possible long-term lease.

We have a request from Technology Middle School to begin their implementation at the beginning of the 2018-19 school year rather than mid-year in January 2019. The Board directed the superintendent to renegotiate the contract to move up the start date based on the same terms and conditions.
