CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION TEACHER ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (CTE TOSA) RPCEA

DEFINITION OF POSITION

Under the direction and supervision of the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, the Career Technical Education Teacher on Special Assignment (CTE TOSA) is responsible for the planning, development, organization, management, direction, and implementation of all aspects of the Career Technical Education programs and related initiatives of the District. The CTE TOSA also assures compliance with laws, codes, and regulations to services related to CTE services, and performs related work as required to ensure that all programs are in alignment with the outcomes for student success as identified in the District's strategic plan.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

The following are typical duties and responsibilities for positions in this classification. Any single position may or may not perform all of these tasks, and/or may perform similar related tasks not listed below:

- Facilitate a collaborative planning process that will engage teachers and administrators in the development and implementation of CTE programs.
- Expand and enhance existing CTE pathways, TK-12.
- Expand and enhance dual-enrollment opportunities, ensuring equitable access for all students.
- Support in the facilitation and collaboration with school sites to integrate research-based strategies and methodologies into the CTE classroom practice.
- Ensure grant applications for CTEIG, SWP, Perkins, WBL, etc, are completed with fidelity and by the deadline established by CDE.
- Seek grant funding to continue the expansion and sustainability of CTE programs
- Assist secondary schools in ensuring equitable access to CTE and A-G courses.
- Work with site staff in monitoring and adjusting such things as master schedule, interventions, and credit recovery to support equitable access to CTE and related programs.
- Assist site administrators in monitoring curriculum so that it meets the definition of "high quality" per CDE model curriculum standards for CTE courses.
- Establish measurable program effectiveness goals and complete ongoing measurement and documentation of program effectiveness.
- Ensure coaching support for sites based on needs and priorities as indicated by data.
- Collaborate with the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services to complete documentation and assist with the coordination of evaluation activities (e.g., surveys, focus groups, and interviews).
- Manage reporting to ensure compliance with Ed Code, board policy, and legal mandates.
- Develop, maintain, and sustain industry and post-secondary institution partnerships, including other organizations such as the CTE Foundation, SCOE, Sonoma Corp, etc.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
