## 1.0 Volunteer In-Person Activities During Distance Learning

- 1. Allow unit members to volunteer to complete one-on-one assessments for Special Education or to provide Special Education services by appointment.
- Extra-curricular activities are paid, voluntary positions. They involve both RPCEA
  and non-RPCEA adults. Safety protocols outlined in the previous sections of the
  MOU will be adhered to during extra-curricular activities. The district will follow
  guidelines from the California Department of Health, as well as the bodies for
  relevant activities (e.g.CIF for athletics).
- 3. Allow unit members to volunteer to provide in person tutoring during non-contract hours for the 2020-2021 school year at the hourly rate.
- 4. Allow unit members to volunteer to provide in person interventions in the summer at the hourly rate.

## 2.0 RPCEA members may volunteer to engage in in-person activities with students under the following parameters:

- 1. Unit members volunteering to be on campus will be prioritized for vaccines.
- 2. Students will have temperature checks upon entering the school.
- 3. In sites without the thermal scanners, unit members may volunteer to assist with temperature taking.
- 4. All staff and students will wear masks and have access to shields in addition to masks upon request.
- 5. Crisis Go system deployed for health and safety monitoring prior to students coming onto campus.
- Unit Members will interact outdoors with a pod of students no greater than 14 at any one time, following all social distance and masking guidelines, and using the most current CIF and health guidelines.
- 7. When possible, Unit Members will only interact with one student when indoors following all social distance and masking guidelines, and using the most current CIF and health guidelines. Doors and windows should be open when possible.
- 8. Indoor environments will have needle-point bipolar ionization.
- 9. Covid testing will follow guidance on p. 40 of COVID-19 and Reopening In-Person Instruction Framework & Public Health Guidance for K-12 Schools in California, 2020-2021 School Year, or more updated document.

10. Site administrators will inform RPCEA site leadership of unit members' extracurricular activities.
