Student Services

Student Services is currently working with sites to assist with 2022-2023 enrollment and to assist families requesting to enroll in the district for 2022-2023. Student Services staff are also spending time at school sites to support principals. This support allows principals to spend time in classrooms supporting new teachers. Our department is also working on the LCAP rough draft and preparing for our final LCAP Committee meeting on Monday, May 23, 2022. In the LCAP meeting, we'll be reviewing the changes made to the 2022-2023 LCAP and also looking at our student and parent input surveys to see what they think about the various LCAP action items.

Cal/OSHA ETS (Emergency Temporary Standards)

Cal/OSHA has adopted a new version of the ETS which is in effect now until 12/31/22. Regardless of vaccination status:

- *Workers are required to wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days after testing positive (if returning to work early)*
- *Workers are required to wear a well-fitting mask for 10 days after a close contact (within 6' for 15+ minutes) whether the exposure occurs in the community or while at work*
- *Workers are required to test 3-5 days after a close contact if they wish to remain in the workplace*

Antigen Testing Update

CDPH is planning to release a document regarding the decreased accuracy of negative antigen test in symptomatic people- there is a greater chance of having positive test results after two days of symptoms.

- *Immunized people have a faster immune response, resulting in earlier symptoms, resulting in a longer lag time for a vaccinated/previously infected person to show a positive test.*
- *If symptoms persist after a negative test, re-testing is key.*

Reminders:

- *Unvaccinated staff members are required to test once a week*
